Job Goal:

To develop and implement an exemplary instrumental music program that will provide the best possible educational opportunities for each student band member

Duties & Responsibilities:

- 1. Ensures band program is consistently ranked among the top programs at the district and state levels
- 2. Directs high school instrumental performers, such as marching band, orchestra, concert band, soloists, and ensembles
- 3. Establishes performance requirements, enforces academic requirements, and verifies each student's eligibility to participate in band
- 4. Provides for band participation at extracurricular events, including concerts, football games, pep rallies, parades, and other school and district activities as requested
- 5. Creates an environment conducive to learning and appropriate for the physical, social, and emotional development of students
- 6. Obtains and uses evaluative findings (including student achievement data) to determine program effectiveness and ensure that program renewal is continuous and responds to student needs
- 7. Arranges transportation, lodging, and meals for all band events
- 8. Complies with all district, state, and other policies related to the area of band
- 9. Adheres to all financial policies of the district in regard to the collection and disbursement of money, expenses, and receipts
- 10. Maintains necessary records and completes required paperwork in a specified time and manner
- 11. Oversees the band auxiliary, ensuring all district policies are followed, and supports band auxiliary activities
- 12. Ensures that programs are cost-effective and funds are managed wisely
- 13. Compiles budgets and cost estimates based on documented program needs and presents budget requests to administration
- 14. Coordinates fundraising activities and manages funds in accordance with district policies
- 15. Oversees process of cleaning, repairing, and storing all band equipment
- 16. Maintains current inventory of all fixed assets within program
- 17. Applies and enforces student discipline in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and student handbook
- 18. Supervises students in band halls and fields to ensure appropriate behavior
- 19. Takes all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities
- 20. Accompanies and supervises students on the bus to and from all band events

- 21. Ensures that medical and safety requirements are followed
- 22. Establishes and maintains open communication by conducting conference with parents, students, principals, and teachers as needed
- 23. Coordinates with administration and other school officials in the scheduling of all band events and the use of school facilities in a collaborative manner
- 24. Adheres to all financial policies of the district in regard to the collection and disbursement of money, expenses, and receipts
- 25. Maintains necessary records and completes required paperwork in a specified time and manner
- 26. Appropriately maintains and secures confidential records and inquiries
- 27. Monitors the performance of associate and assistant band directors
- 28. Demonstrated professional behavior at all times with the students, parents, teachers, administrators, community, and the media; and works to resolve conflicts in a professional manner; adheres to the Mississippi Code of Ethics
- 29. Promotes the district's vision, mission, and goals
- 30. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as requested/assigned by the Principal, Assistant Principal, and Superintendent
